

THE CILIP CARNEGIE AND KATE GREENAWAY VIDEO COMPETITION

**Record a short film about YOUR shadowing group!
...talk to camera... capture your discussions....give a sneak peek
inside the books you are reading. Show us why you think your
shadowing group is brilliant!**

Competition details

We're asking shadowing groups to get creative and record a short film about your shadowing group.

Your video should be simple and does not need to be edited and should not include any production enhancement. We want basic video clips of up to 180 seconds max, filmed directly on a phone, tablet or camera.

Prizes

Prizes are available for two shadowing groups:

One Carnegie winner - must be at secondary school level

One Kate Greenaway winner - must be at primary school level

The two winning shadowing groups will win a set of tickets for up to ten shadowers and up to two group leaders to attend the announcement ceremony on **Tuesday 18 June 2019** in London.

Please note that travel costs are not covered by CILIP and would need to be arranged by your organisation.

How to enter

Record a short video of your shadowing group and upload this video to your shadowing group homepage. Send us an email at **ckg@cilip.org.uk** once the video is live.

Uploading a video to your group homepage requires you to publish the video first to one of the following free video platforms: Vimeo, Youtube or Archive.org. See the next page for further details.

Deadline: Video entries must be submitted by **5pm** on **Monday 13 May 2019**.

Publishing and uploading your video:

1. Film the video on your phone, tablet, camera or video recorder and save the file to your computer
2. If you don't already have one, create an account for free and login at Archive.org, Vimeo or YouTube
3. Follow the onscreen instructions to upload your video file to the platform. Videos should be uploaded by Group Leaders only using their login.
4. When the video is live on your chosen platform, copy (share) the video URL, then log in to edit your group homepage and paste the link in the box for 'Group video'.
5. Click Submit and test that the video plays in your page.
6. Email ckg@cilip.org.uk with a link to your shadowing group home page containing the video.

N.B. Please use only the video sites listed above as other sites might cause problems which prevent users from accessing your group home page.

Judging

The CILIP Carnegie and Kate Greenaway Awards team will select the two best videos. The winning groups and runner up will be contacted during the last week of May and announced in our weekly email bulletin.

Terms and conditions

- o We can only consider entries from UK-based groups currently registered for the CILIP Carnegie and Kate Greenaway Awards shadowing scheme.
- o Videos must be uploaded to group home page on the shadowing website.
- o Only one entry per shadowing group per category is permitted.
- o To be eligible, entries must be created according to the specific competition requirements stated on this page.
- o By entering the competition, you give permission for your group to be named and your video to be shared, played and promoted by the competition promoter, CILIP as part of their promotional activity, events and communications.
NB: You should adhere to the policies of your own school or library with regards parental permission for children under 16 featuring in these videos. The videos will appear on a public webpage.
- o The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the judges' decisions.
- o No cash alternatives to prizes are available.
- o Prizes are not transferable.
- o Only ticket holders can attend the awards ceremony.
- o Your school or library organisation is responsible for seeking parental permission for shadowing children to attend the ceremony and for their safety and wellbeing when in attendance as well as travel arrangements.
- o CILIP reserves the right to change the competition information or rules at any time.
