1. Access

We have chosen to use a commercial streaming platform (Livestream) so the stream can be played directly via our website. We believe this will provide the best possible level of accessibility for those viewing the video within schools and libraries where many free video platforms like Youtube and Vimeo can be restricted/blocked.

We hope all our shadowing groups will be able to access the video and share in the day's events with us, but we cannot guarantee universal access. The functionality and quality of the video stream will depend on your school or library's IT settings & individual user access permissions, the appropriate software to play video material and suitable broadband and internet connection.

2. Technical preparation

For the best possible chance of being able to watch the video, please check or ask your IT team or web manager to ensure the following:

- Your internet connection and/or broadband must be working properly and connected at the location and terminal in question
- Adobe Flash Player (or an equivalent plugin or media player software) must be installed on the computer
- Check if the [CKG website](#) can be accessed via the terminal on which you plan to watch the video
- Please ensure that your computer can play sound
- Please test your access to the video page before the 19th by following the detailed test instructions below

3. Test

Test the video streaming experience in advance by following the steps below:

1. Check out if you are able to view similar video streams by visiting the Watch page of the Livestream website: <https://livestream.com/watch>. This page is playing live events currently being streamed however if it does not play for you, you may need to check the problem with your IT person.
2. Please note that we cannot offer individual groups IT support. If you do experience issues, please ask the advice of your web manager or IT department.
3. If you still have an issue, you can send the details to us in advance at ckg@cilip.org.uk

4. On the day

As long as there are no barriers preventing filming, the live stream will be available directly via the CKG website between 12 and 1.15pm (approx.) on Tuesday 18 June www.carnegiegreenaway.org.uk/stream.php

A note from CILIP

We are a small team of CILIP communications staff who work on the CKG event and shadowing activity.

On the day of the ceremony, Tuesday 18 June, the majority of the team and other members of CILIP staff will be at the event, helping to ensure that it runs smoothly.
